Best Character: Howie

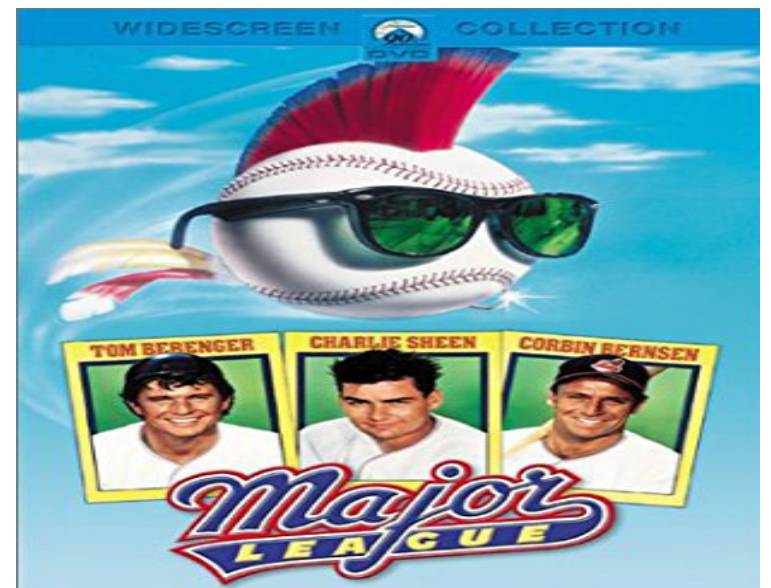
3. Bad News Bears (2005)
